## GUIDELINES TO PREPARE YOUR ARTICLE

Articles approved after a review process are going to be printed in a monograph on Challenges to Intensive Livestock Production while Taking into Consideration Environmental Protection, EU Standards and Alternative Energy Sources, including Biogas.

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Text edited in MS Word, 12 point Times New Roman, single line spacing
- All margins set to 25 mm. Photographs, graphs, tables, drawings, etc. should be black and white and legible.
- Articles should be sent by e-mail as an attachment in DOC format: [konferencjafalenty@itp.edu.pl](mailto:konferencjafalenty@itp.edu.pl)

### ARTICLE SHOULD INCLUDE:

- full name of the author, name of the institution, city - all in the top left-hand corner, 12 Times New Roman, followed by double line spacing,
- title of the paper (middle of page) in uppercase, bold print, followed by single line spacing,
- **Abstract** - in the middle of the page, bold print, volume of the abstract in Polish up to 12 lines, followed by single line spacing; **Key words up to 5 words**, bold type aligned to the left margin,
- chapter titles written in uppercase from the left-hand margin, bold type,
- citations in Polish articles: surnames in square brackets in capital letters, e.g. [KOWALSKI, NOWAK 2020], citations in English articles: [1].
- **LITERATURE**: written from the left margin, with particular items following the pattern below: KOWALSKI W. 2004. Guidelines for the preparation of papers. Conference Organization, 9(20), pp. 49-58. In English, add the reference number: e.g. [1] KOWALSKI W. 2004. Guidelines for the preparation of papers. Conference Organisation, 9(20), pp. 49-58.
- Abstract in English, up to 1 A4 page; title in English in capital letters, bold type, middle of page; author's name in lowercase, middle of page; **Summary**: lowercase, bold type, middle of page; **Key words**: lowercase, bold type, left margin alignment.

### GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING A PRESENTATION

Presentations in Polish should include:

- title of presentation in English on one slide;
- abbreviated translation of Polish text into English on the remaining slides; additionally: descriptions to tables, photos and charts in English.

Presentations can be delivered in Polish and/or English.
